## **UNCLAIMED CIVIL WAR MEDALS**

## Doddridge County, West Virginia

In 1866, the state of West Virginia authorized the minting of nearly 27,000 medals to honor its Union Civil War soldiers. Today, over 4,000 medals remain unclaimed.

Below is a list of those Doddridge County Civil War veterans whose medals have not been claimed. Click the hyperlinked names to learn more about each veteran and determine if perhaps you are descended from him in some way, and thus possibly be eligible for his medal. Names that are not hyperlinked are those soldiers for whom we have found little or no family information.
